A Moment for Giving

Guidelines for Presenters

The Moment for Giving is presented before the offering is received during our worship services. The purpose is to prepare the congregation for the offering, thank them for their financial support and let them know how their gifts are working in God's Kingdom.

We provide all Moment for Giving speakers with a script in advance. You may customize the script with your personal experience or use it as provided.

Please practice your presentation in advance. You should prepare for your Moment for Giving presentation in the same way the preacher prepares a sermon.

Please be ready to begin speaking at the scheduled time in the service. Move to the front of the sanctuary during the element of the service immediately preceding the Moment for Giving so there is a seamless transition to your presentation.

Begin by letting people know that we will be receiving an offering in just a few minutes. This gives people a chance to prepare their offering (write a check, get out cash) if they give during the service. A simple phrase such as, "In just a moment we will be receiving an offering" is sufficient.

Thank people for their gifts and support at some point during your presentation.

Make your presentation as personal as you are comfortable with. Quote scripture, tell stories—whatever you feel called to say.

End your presentation by inviting the ushers to come forward to receive our gifts, then return to your seat as the music begins.

If you customize your message, please keep your total presentation to no more than two (2) minutes.
